b) Matters Arising

Plaque for Monolith clerk reported the plaque would be delivered at the end of May Cost £220. delivery charge extra.

Suggested car park for Caersws station, Arriva not interested until after tender for service 2018. Members suggested that the additional train serviced would add to the number of vehicles needing parking spaces and this should be highlighted in a letter to Network Rail. Caersws W.C's Contracts Powys and Healthmatic are to be signed. Powys C.C. will meet the clerk and chairman on the 7th May for meter readings and handover of keys. Healthmatic will take over the maintenance on the 8th May.

- a) **Powys County Council** General Dispensation School Modernisation no comment made letter on file.
- b) **Powys County Council** Highway Matters Caersws. The reported deterioration on the road surface on the B4389 will be attended to. Powys C,C. will contact the owners of the tree causing problems in Llanwnog. Also mentioned was the scattered litter from the recycle vehicle Powys are addressing this issue.

- d) **Powys County Council** Level Crossing Issue in Caersws. Powys have contacted Network Rail and they are to contact the transport company in question. Powys stated they felt there was sufficient white lines to deter parking but are not prepare to apply a yellow do not enter box as the white lines in their view were adequate as per the highway code. Clerk to write again to regarding the white lines as they are not very noticeable and again mention the yellow box warning. Also to mention there is a yellow junction box at the level crossing in Shrewsbury on Harlescott Lane.
